

Waiver and Release of Liability Form

Please read this carefully before you participate

Welcome to the Driver Skills Enhancement Course (the “Program”). As we all know, driving is serious business, and learning to drive requires patience and experience. A one day course cannot replace the hours of behind the wheel instruction and experience that parents provide to their teen drivers. In addition, the most important contributors to driving safety are your safety belts, which should be worn by you and all your passengers at all times, whenever you are driving.

It is also important to reduce distractions when anyone is driving, particularly a new driver. Things like hand-held cell phones and radios can divert attention from the task at hand at absolutely the wrong time. It is also a good idea to limit the time young drivers initially spend driving in certain conditions, like at night, on wet or slick roads, or with passengers, so they can learn these skills gradually and with the proper level of experience.

Finally, it is critical that you apply what is learned in this course properly to help avoid crashes. The techniques reviewed in this course should never be used to drive aggressively or outside the bounds of prudence or the law. The things learned in this course will not save any driver from themselves if they drive with the wrong attitude. Simply put, drive defensively and carefully whenever you are on the roads.
